



# **Dangerous Intersection**

Saturday morning riders trying to return to the Davidsonville park and ride lot often cross Maryland Route 2 at Harwood Road. If you've tried it, you know how dangerous it can be. ABC President Ken Keeler has contacted the Maryland State Highway Administration. The State sent Jianyang Zheng out, and Ken and Mr. Zheng spent about 45 minutes observing the intersection and discussing possible improvements. Constraints on funds and available land will limit what can be done, but Mr. Zheng promised to see if both the left turn and the north/south green signal times can be increased, and will discuss other possibilities with his colleagues.

**Immediate Action:** The club recommends that all ABC riders cross Rte 2 at Southern High until we see some safety improvements at the intersection. There is a full, striped left turn lane there, and there seems to be better view of oncoming traffic.

## Want To Ride In Washington?

The long awaited Bike Transit Center next to Union Station should open in October. The Center will have 150 enclosed indoor racks, 20 outdoor racks, changing rooms, personal lockers, a bike repair shop, and a store that will sell drinks and bike accessories.

The cost will be \$1 a day for 7 AM to 7 PM access, or you can get a years membership with round the clock access to the racks for \$100. If you work in DC, especially if you are often anywhere near Union Station, this could be well worth looking into.
